Camps at The Stitchcraft Studio are designed to be fun while campers learn, or improve on, their sewing skills. Sessions are limited to a 3:1 ratio of camper to teacher. We supply the sewing machines and all other equipment.

All camps, excluding the Learn to Sew and Fashion Diva Camps, run for five days, two and a half hours each and cost \$175 per week plus kit fees. Kits vary from camp to camp.

A kit will include fabric, thread and all necessary notions (patterns, buttons, zippers etc). Campers will be able to select their individual fabric from a selection at the studio. Sessions run as follows:

Morning 10 – 12:30, Afternoon 1 – 3:30,
Evening 6 – 9

Learn-to-Sew Camp for Beginners

This is a single day two and a half hour session for campers who have never sewn before or need a refresher. It will cover learning how to use a sewing machine, including threading, winding bobbins and practice straight and pivot stitches. Also covered is pinning and cutting fabric and assembling a tote bag to carry their supplies for future camps.

This one day camp is a pre-requisite for all campers with little or no sewing experience. Once completed campers may sign up for most of the other camps.
